JOB DESCRIPTION:

Conducts swimming classes in District Youth Services programs that include teaching beginner through advanced techniques. A Swimming Instructor (Recreation) teaches swimming classes. A Senior Swimming Instructor teaches swimming classes, trains pool swimming personnel, and is responsible for unit personnel and pool facilities in the absence of the Pool Supervisor.

Typical Duties:

Teaches swimming, lifesaving, and diving to persons of all ages who have varying degrees of skill by following prescribed lesson plans and developing supplementary plans as necessary.

- Rotates lifeguard duties on an hourly basis with instructional duties.
- Checks air temperature and chemical content and temperature of water and brings deviations to the attention of persons responsible for pool maintenance.
- Assists in setting up and securing portable pools.
- Sets up and inspects pool equipment and reports unsanitary and unsafe conditions to the appropriate authority.
- Performs minor emergency repair, maintenance, and clean-up work required to prevent accidents and to maintain maximum health conditions.

- Assists with public relations activities, such as orientation lectures for parents and children.
- Performs related duties as assigned.
